Every young person who is nominated receives a **certificate of merit** to recognise their achievement and the most outstanding young people receive a unique **Tryangle Award** at our fantastic awards evening. This inspiring event will be held on Thursday 23rd March 2017 at the headquarters of Worcester Bosch in Worcester.



Inspirational stories...

Previous recipients include:

- George who had a disrupted childhood and 'no one wanted to teach' who turned his life around and is now standing as Head Student
- Alisa who is always positive despite being a young carer and as eldest child of six children spends a lot of time looking after her disabled sisters
- Joe who is passionate about his local community and set up a football team at age 14 because there wasn't one in his area, secured a pitch, trained as a coach and secured 3 year funding for the club
- Matt - a young man with cerebral palsy and epilepsy who pioneered disability boxing and runs successful children's boxing sessions



Award Categories

Young people are recognised in 6 award areas:

- ☆ **Bravery** - those who have shown personal courage and determination. They might have faced up to personal difficulties, dealt with tough matters at home or in the community, or volunteer for others despite having to overcome adversity or challenging circumstances.
- ☆ **Personal Achievement in Arts or Music** - for young people with a proven achievement in a wide range of arts including dance, film, performing arts, music and crafts. Or those who work hard to support and encourage others to get involved.
- ☆ **Personal Achievement in Sports** - for young people who participate in sport at any level, or coach and encourage others.
- ☆ **Good Friends and Carers** - those who selflessly help their families and friends and give their time and efforts to support others in need.
- ☆ **Citizenship and Environment** - for young people who show they are good citizens through volunteering within their local community, either by improving the environment or promoting well-being.
- ☆ **Personal Development** - for the determined young people who have demonstrated outstanding personal growth, often through a difficult journey to reach their personal goals.

Adult Volunteer Leader

- ☆ Our additional category for **Adult Volunteer Leader** was a huge success when we introduced it last year and we are pleased to continue it again. This award acknowledges the outstanding contribution and effort that volunteer leaders make to our clubs, communities and young people in Worcestershire.
